Bell Tower loves summer time! The flowers are in full bloom, baseball games are plentiful, staff members are taking some well deserved vacations and sunshine is plentiful!

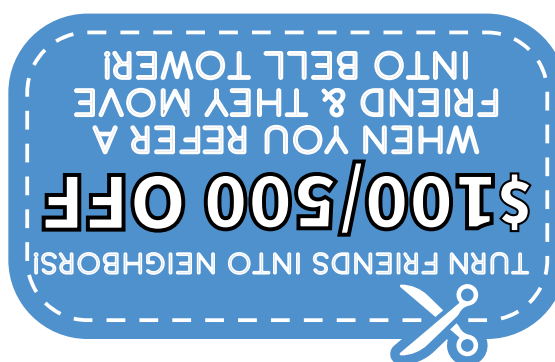

Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update:

Bell Tower continues to do screening of both our residents and staff members if anyone is symptomatic for COVID-19. During our screening process, we discovered three residents and one staff member are positive for COVID-19. The employee was immediately sent home to quarantine. We have all positive residents quarantined in their apartments. We are keeping a very close watch on all our residents as we have done so all along. All residents are asked to stay in their room and not visit with other residents during this 14 day period. If residents come out of their room they must wear masks. All activities are cancelled for 14 days. Meals will be served to the resident room for 14 days.

The safety of our residents and staff is our priority. For the next 14 days, we are locking the front door and stopping visitation to the building. All residents, staff and visitors must wear masks at all times. Items can be dropped off at the front door from 9 am to 4 pm and will be delivered to the resident by the staff. Please ring the outside doorbell to notify staff. Please call the office if there are special requests or circumstances that may be allowed.

We will continue to monitor all residents closely, completing vital signs daily and asking the symptom screening questions.

Please know that we are doing the following:

- Positive residents should not leave the building unless it is critically necessary.
- Please stay in touch with your loved one by calling often, using means of video chat, and other means of communication. Call the facility for assistance if needed.

I want you to know that we are taking every precaution to prevent further spread of this infection. I also know that you may have general questions, and I encourage you to contact our facility.

We also need your help in battling COVID-19. Please visit the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) website to learn how you can help prevent the spread in the community.

We know this is a difficult time for everyone. Please know that my team and I are strictly adhering to all directions from the Jo Daviess County Health Department and Illinois Department of Public Health.

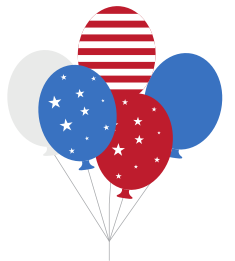
